TASTING NOTES:

AROMAS OF WILD BERRIES, RED CURRANT, AND BLACK CHERRY ARE SPICED WITH CASSIS, CEDARY OAK AND A TOUCH OF CLOVE. THE RICH, SMOOTH PALATE FOLLOWS WITH A DENSE CORE OF RIPE BLACKBERRY, CHERRY PRESERVES, VANILLA, AND ESPRESSO. THE LONG, PERSISTENT FINISH AND MELLOW TANNINS MAKE THIS WINE EXTREMELY VERSATILE IN FOOD PAIRINGS.
